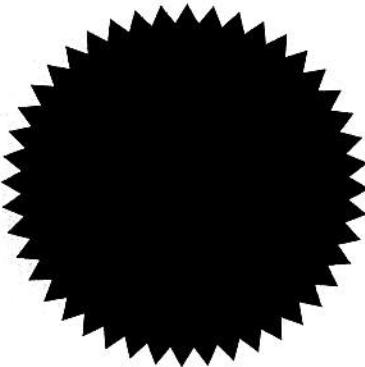

**ORDER**

**THIS MOTION** made by Albert Gelman Inc. (“AGI”) in its capacity as Liquidator (the  
“Liquidator”) of Tulleidin Investments Limited (“Tulleidin”) for Orders authorizing the

Liquidator to distribute the remaining assets of Tulleidin (which corporation had amalgamated with Engines for Industry Limited) to Tulleidin's sole shareholder, the Estate of John Douglas Crashley (the "**Crashley Estate**"), authorizing the Liquidator to finalize the windup of Tulleidin pursuant to Section 207 of the Ontario *Business Corporations Act* (the "**OBCA**") and to effect the dissolution of Tulleidin, including by filing a certified copy of the relevant order with the Ontario Ministry of Government Services and publishing a notice in the Ontario Gazette and discharging the Liquidator upon filing a certificate in the form attached hereto, was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

**ON READING** the Notice of Motion, the Third Report of the Liquidator dated April 3, 2014 (the "**Third Report**") and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Liquidator and all other interested parties,

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for service of the Notice of Motion and Motion Record in support of this Motion be and is hereby abridged and that this Motion is properly returnable today, and further that service thereof upon any person other than those set out on the Notice of Motion be and is hereby dispensed with.

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the actions and activities of the Liquidator as set out in the Third Report, including the Liquidator's Interim Statement of Receipts and Disbursements dated April 3, 2013, be and the same are hereby approved.

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND APPROVES** the fees and disbursements of the Liquidator for the period August 20, 2013, to March 31, 2014, plus the Liquidator's estimated fees and disbursements to complete its mandate as Liquidator which are set out in the Liquidator's Estimated Final Statement of Receipts and Disbursements dated April 3, 2014.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND APPROVES** the fees and disbursements of the Liquidator's counsel, Blaney McMurtry LLP, for the period August 21, 2013, to March 31, 2014, plus the estimated fees and disbursements of Blaney McMurtry LLP to complete its role as counsel for the Liquidator which are set out in the Liquidator's Estimated Final Statement of Receipts and Disbursements dated April 3, 2014.

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND APPROVES** that the Liquidator distribute the remaining assets of Tulleidin to the Crashley Estate as provided for in the Third Report, net of a holdback for the Liquidator's estimated fees and disbursements to complete its mandate as Liquidator, as follows:

- (a) the filing of Tulleidin's final corporation tax return with Canada Revenue Agency ("CRA") for the terminal year-end and receipt of CRA's assessment of this year-end and payment of any liabilities due to the CRA, if any; and
- (b) receipt of a clearance certificate confirming that there are no amounts owing to CRA from Tulleidin.

6. **THIS COURT AUTHORIZES** the Liquidator to finalize the windup of Tulleidin pursuant to Section 207 of the *OBCA* and effect the dissolution of Tulleidin including, by filing a certified copy of the relevant order with the Ontario Ministry of Government Services and publishing a notice in the Ontario Gazette.

7. **THIS COURT DISCHARGES** the Liquidator upon filing a Certificate in the form attached hereto and marked as Schedule "A".
