UPON THE Application of Superior Paint & Autobody Corp. ("Superior") AND UPON having read the First Report (the "Trustee's First Report") of Albert Gelman Inc. (the "Trustee"), in its capacity as trustee in the Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal of Superior (the "NOI"), dated August 6, 2025; AND UPON having read the NOI filed under section 50.4 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c B-3 (the "BIA"), as amended, which resulted an automatic stay of proceedings against Superior or its property for 30 days from the date of filing; AND UPON noting the Affidavit of Nadyne Brost sworn on August 26, 2025, AND UPON it appearing that all interested and affected parties have been served with notice of the Application; AND UPON hearing the submissions of counsel for Superior, and any other counsel or interested parties present;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The time for service of the notice of application is hereby abridged and deemed good and sufficient and this application is properly returnable today.
2. The time for SUPERIOR PAINT & AUTOBODY CORP. to make a proposal to their creditors, and the time for the Trustee to file such proposal with the official receiver, be and is hereby extended to and including October 20, 2025, pursuant to section 50.4(9) of the BIA.
3. The Trustee's First Report, and the activities of the Trustee described therein, are hereby approved, provided, however, that only the Trustee in its personal capacity and only with respect to its own personal liability shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way such approval.

4. Service of this Order may be effected by facsimile, electronic mail, personal delivery or courier. Service is deemed to be effected the next business day following transmission or delivery of this Order.
